Boundaries On the Water

- All water users to stay out of areas marked with an orange buoy on the map.
- You can ONLY go past the red buoys marked on the map and access the remaining area of the reservoir if you are in a group of 2 or more craft & deemed self sufficient by a member of staff, meaning each craft can effectively self rescue and are carrying an effective form of communication.

Please note buoys pictured on the map may be different colours in real life. Boundaries maybe altered dependant on weather conditions on the day of launch.

General Rules

- On arrival please sign in at reception before getting ready to go on the water.
- All craft must be clean and dry before launching on the water to avoid the spread of any invasive species carried from other waterways. Please use the boat/board wash area provided after your time on the water with us.
- All self launch must provide their own buoyancy aids or PFD belts. These must be worn by all water users at all times, this includes when standing on the jetty.
- We allow the launch of plastic, fiberglass & inflatable Paddleboards (SUPs), Canoes & Kayaks.
- Inflatable Canoes & Kayaks MUST have more than one inflation valve and a multi chamber construction.
- Rowing boats and motorised craft are prohibited.
- All paddleboards must have an ankle or waist leash attached to the paddler when on the water.
- Please be considerate of signage for ground nesting birds when launching/having a picnic.
- Smoking, Alcohol and Drugs are prohibited whilst out on the water.
- All craft to be off the water by 4:30pm, gates close at 5pm. Access to the water is from the watersports centre only and during centre opening hours. Car parking is available at the watersports centre free of charge for all customers.
- Safety Cover will be available at all times however this will be for emergency recovery only. Please assess your own ability, weather conditions and equipment prior to going afloat. Only launch in conditions within your capabilities.
- It is at the managements discretion to refuse launch or ask you to leave if the above rules are not adhered to.
- Management has the right to refuse launch upon sign in if the conditions are deemed unsuitable for the craft or users experience..

Please take into consideration the weather conditions and your level of ability before going on the water
